What is Read Write Inc Phonics?

- A programme that helps your child to learn to read and write quickly and easily.



When will my child have a phonics lesson?

- 1 hour session that includes phonics, reading and writing every day!
- Your child will still take part in whole class English activities, linked to their topic.
 - Your child will also have a separate handwriting session everyday.
- Your child will be heard 1:1 reading each week as a separate session.

- The children learn one way of reading and spelling each of the sounds in the English language.
- They are given a hook to learn the sounds, by using pictures that are the same shape as the letters. This helps children to recognise and write the sounds more easily.

- o Children then read books that are carefully matched to the sounds that they have been taught.
- o When children start to read books confidently, we gradually introduce alternative ways to spell each sound.

During RWI, we only ask children to read books that contain the sounds and spellings that they have been taught.

This helps to build confidence quickly as children can be really successful.

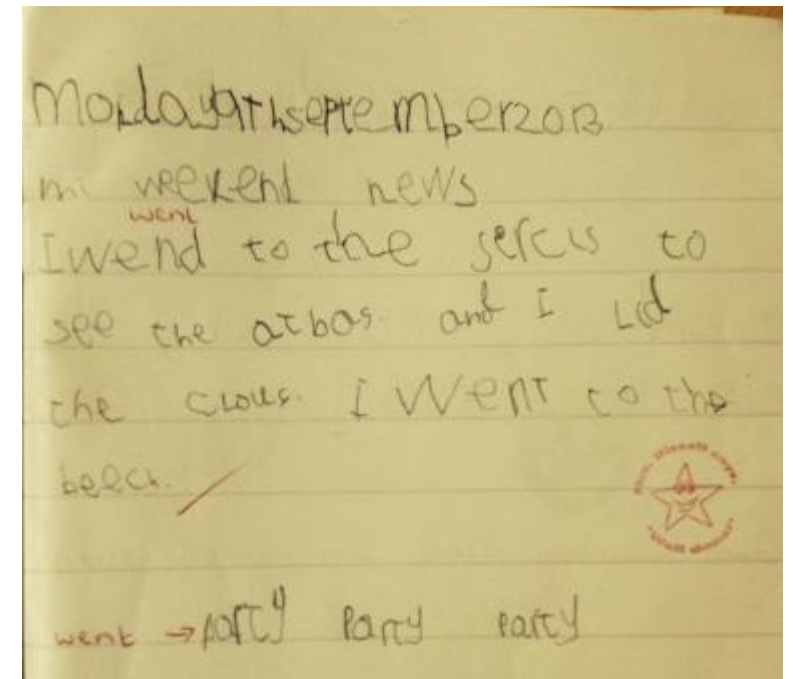
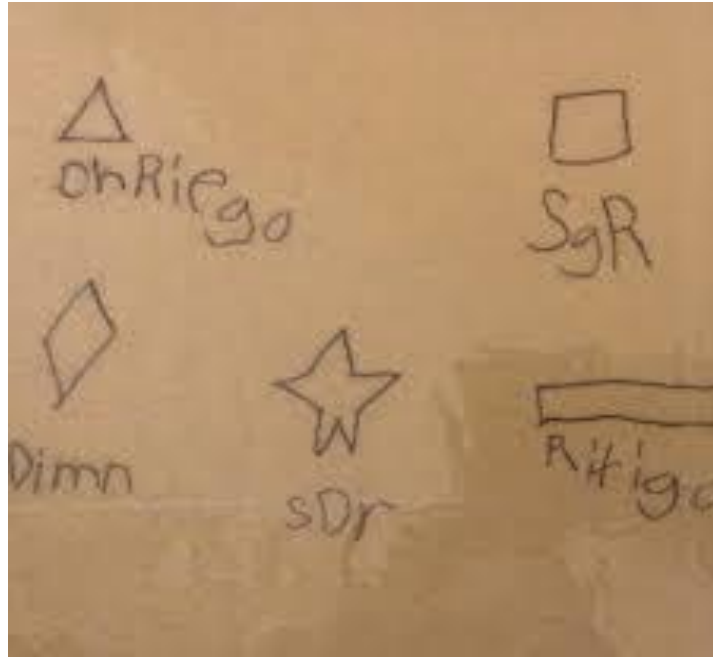

We also build in daily storytime opportunities so that children still have lots of experience of real books and storybook language.

RWI makes it easy for your child to succeed.

They are grouped according to the sounds that they know.

They are taught in smaller groups than whole class-size groups. They are only ever expected to read and write words using sounds that they know.



During Read Write Inc. children will read everyday and will be heard read within the group, they will read words both individually and within sentences in books.

The children will repeat and work on the book sometimes for up to four days.

The children will bring home books that are linked to the stage they are reading at. Once they have read the book they will not automatically have their book changed and repeating and becoming fluent is what we are aiming for.

We look for children being able to read all of the sounds/words independently.

Please don't think the book is too easy - we will have worked very hard in school to help the children get to that level of fluency with their reading.

The reading record needs to be signed every night.

What books will my child bring home?

- . Their decodable book (book linked to phonics level)
- .A book for pleasure
- .A library book
